SIGN OF REVERENCE AT HOLY COMMUNION A small reminder following my homily last week. It is important that there should be a worthy procession forward to the priest or minister as we approach Holy Communion and on reception of Holy Communion it is recommended that there should be a bow to each species (i.e. the Host and the Precious Blood). This, as I stated, was the preference from the Bishops of England & Wales and it is trying to ensure we recognise in a more ritual expression what it is we are receiving.
